



## Artisan Scholarship

The Granville Education Foundation provides grants to Granville Exempted Village School District Teachers to promote innovation in the schools and classrooms. In this spirit, one \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior at Granville Exempted Village School District who has had significant involvement in performing arts or fine arts during their high school years. This includes participating in band, orchestra, choir, theatre, or art. Applicants must have a minimum 2.0 GPA and intend to enroll in an accredited institution of higher learning.

The scholarship recipient will have demonstrated a commitment to the performing arts or fine arts, displayed good citizenship, and exhibited a positive influence at Granville High School.

### Granville Education Foundation Artisan Scholarship Requirements

To be considered, applicants need to:

1. Have a minimum 2.0 Grade Point Average
2. Plan to attend an accredited institution of higher learning
3. Provide one (1) letter of recommendation from a GHS faculty member or member of the community who can attest to your artistic endeavors
4. Write an essay of no more than 500 words expressing how participation in the performing arts or fine arts have impacted your high school experience
5. Include a list of performing or exhibition experiences during high school and identify any significant performances, shows, and recognitions/awards (please limit your responses to high school years; list does not count in the 500 word limit)

All applicants are required to complete the online application **no later than March 15, 2024**.
