



What I Did Scholarship

The Granville Education Foundation provides grants to Granville Exempted Village School District Teachers to promote innovation in the schools and classrooms. In this spirit, one \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior of the Granville Exempted Village School District. What I Did Scholarship applicants are to identify something innovative or creative you did while a student at Granville High School and provide an essay explanation of how what you did relates to you as a student. The What I Did Scholarship is open to all graduating Granville Exempted Village School District seniors who meet the following criteria.

Granville Education Foundation What I Did Scholarship Requirements

To be considered, applicants need to:

1. Have a minimum 2.0 Grade Point Average
2. Plan to attend an accredited post-secondary institution
3. Provide one (1) letter of recommendation from GHS faculty member or member of the community
4. Write an essay of no more than 500 words explaining how what you did relates to who you are as a student. Identify the following information about something innovative or creative you did while a student at Granville High School:
 - a. Name of project, event, item, etc.
 - b. Student's specific role
 - c. Outcome

All applicants are required to complete the online application **no later than March 15, 2024**.
