



Who I Am Scholarship

The Granville Education Foundation provides grants to Granville Exempted Village School District Teachers to promote innovation in the schools and classrooms. In this spirit, Who I Am Scholarship applicants are to provide a creative representation of his/her/themselves as a student. Applicants have a choice of one of three methods to symbolically show how the applicant thinks of him/her/themselves as a student, and all applicants are to provide an essay explanation of his/her/their choice. The Who I Am Scholarship is open to all graduating Granville Exempted Village School District seniors who meet the following criteria.

Granville Education Foundation Who I Am Scholarship Requirements

Please limit your responses to high school years.

To be considered, applicants need to:

1. Have a minimum 2.0 Grade Point Average
2. Plan to attend an accredited post-secondary institution
3. Provide one (1) letter of recommendation from a GHS faculty member or member of the community
4. Choose one of the prompts to compose an essay of no more than 500 words explaining how your choice represents your identity as a student. The choices are:

(1) Work of Art

Provide a picture of any work of art that you believe represents you as a student. This is not to be a work of art that you have created.

(2) Song or Piece of Music

Provide the written lyrics to a song or a link to a piece of music that you believe represents you as a student. You must also provide the title and composer for either choice. This is not to be a song or music that you have created.

(3) Seven Words

List seven words that you believe represent you as a student.

All applicants are required to complete the online application **no later than March 15, 2024**.
